



UGA College of Engineering Excellence in Faculty Leadership Award

The College of Engineering (CENGR) is pleased to announce the availability of the Excellence in Faculty Leadership Award. This award recognizes faculty who have demonstrated outstanding leadership that advances the mission of the College of Engineering through strategic vision, collaboration, and impactful contributions to academic and professional communities. The recipient will receive a monetary award of \$1,000, depending on the availability of funds.

Criteria include but are not limited to:

- Demonstrated leadership in advancing school, college, or university initiatives with measurable outcomes.
- Ability to foster collaboration among faculty, staff, and students to achieve shared goals.
- Service in significant leadership roles (e.g., committee chair, program director, task force leader, administrator) with documented impact.

Eligibility

- Nominees must be faculty in the College of Engineering (any rank or track).
- Faculty who have won this award in the past five years are not eligible.
- Affiliate and adjunct faculty members without a primary appointment in the College of Engineering are not eligible.

Nomination Process

- Nominations may be submitted by any CENGR faculty member or by self-nomination.

- Nominations will be accepted until 5:00 pm, February 6th, 2026 (Friday).

Upon receipt of nominations, the CENGR Faculty Honorifics Committee will contact nominees to request a dossier of achievements relevant to this award.

Dossier Requirements

Submit as a single PDF (maximum 15 pages, including appendices/letters):

- Cover Letter (2-page max) describing leadership philosophy, activities, and impact.
- Summary of leadership roles and accomplishments (e.g., initiatives led, outcomes achieved).
- Evidence of impact (e.g., program improvements, student success metrics, recognition).
- Letters of Support (minimum 1, maximum 3) from colleagues, administrators, or collaborators.
- Supporting documents and appendices.
- Dossiers must be submitted by 5:00 PM on February 25, 2026, via the submission link that will be provided later.

Selection and Recognition

- Dossiers will be evaluated by the CENGR Faculty Honorific Committee.
- The recipient will be honored at the CENGR Celebration of Excellence.
