

Lowry Gillespie, Jr. Engineering Curriculum Enhancement Award

Description:

This award recognizes faculty efforts in incorporating experiential learning in UGA engineering courses. Students involved in hands-on projects demonstrate improvement in quality of learning and increased retention of covered material.

The Lowry H. Gillespie, Jr. Engineering Curriculum Enhancement Award will consist of an award of at least \$1,000 which will be made available annually to an engineering faculty member(s) at the University of Georgia to support creative course enhancement or new course development. The course enhancement or development must focus on experiential learning and must involve class projects. Following implementation of the selected project, the faculty member will prepare a report to the faculty outlining the results of the experiential learning in the engineering course.

Application:

- Applications should be a PDF file prepared such that they do not exceed a 5-page limit, double-space, formatted with 12-size font and 1-inch margin all around.
- **Complete applications must be submitted electronically via the [application link here](#) by 5:00 pm, February 28, 2025.**
- Applications will be evaluated by faculty in the Engineering Education Transformations Institute and will recommend an awardee to the College of Engineering Honorifics Committee
- The awardee will be honored at the CENGR Celebration of Excellence.

Selection:

The funds will be available to support courses which will be offered during the following fiscal year. Following implementation of the selected project, the faculty member will prepare a report to the faculty outlining the results of the experiential learning in the engineering course.
